ABOUT SEMINAR

Telangana State, since its formation, has made commendable achievements in terms of economic performance during 2014-17. The vision 2024 document has been prepared in this line. The State economy has turned around since 2014-15 and continued to grow in a higher growth trajectory. The growth of State Domestic Product has surpassed the national growth and is poised for a double digit growth in the current financial year, 2016-17. The living standards, as measured by the per capita income (PCI) of the State, are much higher than the national average. Even the growth of PCI has picked up since formation of the State and growing at much faster pace than that of All India average.

The growth rate of GSDP denotes the performance of the economy and changes in the magnitude and composition of GSDP of the State economy, over a period of time. As per the Advanced Estimates, released by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, the Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) at current prices for the year 2016-17 is estimated at Rs. 6.54 lakh crore, as against Rs. 5.76 lakh crore in the previous year, indicating a growth rate of 13.7 per cent. Telangana's GSDP at constant (2011-12) prices is estimated at Rs. 5.11 lakh crore in 2016-17, compared to the previous year estimates of Rs. 4.64 lakh crores, thereby registering a growth rate of 10.1 per cent.

The share of Telangana's economy in National

GDP is 4.28 percent in 2016-17, as against 4.21 percent in 2015-16. A comparison of State GSDP growth with that of All India growth reveals that since 2014-15, the growth rate of Telangana has picked up and registered higher growth than All India during subsequent years. This is a clear indication of impact of the proactive measures of the Government to spur economic growth, after formation of the State.

The Two day National seminar in Satavahana University tries to discuss the themes whether Telangana development will lead to the growth of GDP of India as well and the fruits of growth spread to down-trodden and will act as an impulse to the trade, commerce and industry. - g. Mission Kakatiya and Bhagiratha
